MEDICATION IN SCHOOL

Prescribed medicine should only be brought to school when it is essential to administer it during the school day.

In the vast majority of cases, doses of medicine can be arranged around the school day thus avoiding the need for medicine in school e.g. antibiotics taken three times a day can be given with breakfast, on getting home from school and then at bedtime.

Only medicines needed to be taken four times a day will be administered by school staff.

Official advice states that non-prescription medicines such as Calpol, throat lozenges and over-the-counter hayfever medications should not be brought into school by parents with the intention that they be administered by school staff.

What is expected of parents?

Whilst on the school premises, parents are expected to act in a polite and respectful manner, ensuring school policies are adhered to, including the Code of Conduct, Visitor Policy and Adult Behaviour Policy.

Why is it important?

What does the law say?

The school has the right to remove individuals from the premises. It is a criminal offence to cause a nuisance or disturbance on school premises - this may result in the police being contacted and a banning order implemented.








We understand that these are quite stressful times but we are noticing that a very small minority of parents are behaving in an intimidating manner when speaking to staff about issues they may feel need resolving.

We are therefore politely reminding parents to please communicate with school staff in a calm and measured way. We are here to help with any problems you may have but this is always made much more difficult if staff are subject to aggressive behaviour.
